## About Deeside College

Welcome to Deeside College. Following mergers in 2009 and 2010, Deeside College, Northop College, Coleg Llysfasi and Wrexham Training are all part of the Deeside College Group of Colleges with one Governing body and one management team. In this handbook you will find key information that you will need as a work based learner.

## Your responsibilities as a work based learner

- Making a positive commitment to your own development and learning.
- Studying and completing work regularly and on time.
- Completing all necessary paperwork as required.
- Completing Individual Learning Plans as required.
- Participating fully in sessions where your progress is reviewed and giving and receiving constructive feedback.
- Promptly bringing any concerns you may have to the attention of an appropriate named contact.
- If you cannot keep an appointment made with your Assessor, please contact them well in advance.

## Your entitlements as a work based learner

You have the right to expect a high quality programme of support and effective management of your learning, which is subject to independent inspection, by ensuring:

- You have an assessment of your needs and understand how they will be met.
- You know how your prior learning will contribute to your planned learning.
- You understand the details of your programme of study and qualifications being followed.
- You know the name of your Assessor / Tutor, how they may be contacted and who you should contact on any issues concerning your programme of learning.
- You receive regular and constructive advice, support and feedback on your performance.
- Any concerns or complaints you may have will be handled quickly and sympathetically.
- You know what to do if you have a complaint, compliment or want to give feedback to us.
- You learn in a safe and secure environment and understand our policy on Health & Safety.
- You are respected as a learner as defined legally and by the College's Equal Opportunities Statement.
- You receive appropriate help and support to deal with literacy, numeracy, study skills and other identified needs.
- You are assessed, taught or trained by people who are competent in the subject area.
- Programmes of learning are managed and co-ordinated to high standards
- You receive information and advice on progress or other learning opportunities.
- You are asked for your views on the quality of your programme of learning and you receive feedback on any improvement actions taken as a result.

## Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are an excellent way of gaining qualifications and workplace experience. As an employee, you can earn as you learn and gain practical skills from the workplace. Of course you may already have many years of experience and skills which will help you in the achievement of your apprenticeship framework. The apprenticeship framework will consist of:

QCF (Qualifications Credit Framework) qualifications, enable learners to undertake learning at various levels awards, certificates and diplomas and recognise that job roles include tasks and responsibilities at different levels. Your Assessor will explain this to you. However if you have already started your NVQ you will be able to complete it.

Essential Skills/Key Skills - are the skills that you need in order to operate confidently and successfully in college, work, training and life in general such as numeracy and literacy. If you have any questions about this please ask your Assessor.

Employment Rights and Responsibilities -

- The rights and responsibilities of workers (including equal opportunities legislation)
- The organisation, disciplines and representative structures of the sector
- The impact on the sector, of public law and policies.

## Learner confidentiality

- Deeside College will ensure that learners' rights to confidentiality of personal information are protected. We believe that all learners should have the right to expect that personal information held about them will be treated with confidentiality and with respect.
- Where learners are encouraged to disclose personal information, this should be with their informed consent. They are entitled to expect clear and transparent information and advice about the implications of disclosure and about their freedom to access and change what is held on record.
- Deeside College is mindful that what is perceived as confidential may vary from learner to learner and from circumstance to circumstance.

- Some information held about you by the College will be sent to the Welsh Government (WG). Your record will be added to a database which will be used to pass information in anonymous form to Welsh Government, central government departments and agencies that require it to carry out their functions under Education Acts.

## Complaints, Compliments and Feedback

Compliments, suggestions and any feedback can be given to your Assessor or you can send them to the Compliments Officer at Deeside College. In addition, all learners are given the opportunity to feedback during their course. The data gathered from this is collated and comments and ideas discussed with management and where possible, improvements made to the service you receive.

We welcome any feedback on the experience you have with us. It is important to us that you feel able to complain, compliment or provide us with feedback in order that we can continue to provide you with a quality service.

If you have a complaint about your training, in the first instance, speak to your Assessor. If you feel you can't speak to your Assessor and wish to make a formal complaint then please write to the Complaints Officer, Deeside College, Kelsterton Road, Connah's Quay, Deeside, Flintshire CH5 4BR. All complaints and comments will be handled promptly, efficiently and courteously, in the strictest confidence. You will receive an initial response informing you that we have received your complaint and we will look into your complaint as soon as we can. We will normally be able to provide a response to you within 15 working days, but if this is not possible, we will keep you informed of progress.

We treat all complaints, compliments and feedback that we receive seriously. We listen to what you are saying and then aim to learn and improve our services wherever we can.

## Health & Safety and Security

It is important that you are able to train in a safe and supportive environment. Deeside College carries out an initial vetting with your employer and conducts regular monitoring of health & safety arrangements in the workplace. Learners also have a duty to prevent injury to themselves or others so please report any accident or danger immediately to your employer. There are a number of general health & safety issues that apply and you should be aware of these at the commencement of your learning. They include:

## Welsh Culture

### Here are some interesting facts about Wales and its culture.

Hen Wlad Fy Nhadau (Land of My Fathers) is the Welsh national anthem. The tune and words were the work of the father and son team of Evan and James James and it was written in 1856.

Saint David's Day (Dydd Gŷl Dewi Sant) is the feast day of Saint David, the patron Saint of Wales, and falls on 1 March each year. The date of 1 March was chosen in remembrance of the death of Saint David on that day in 589. The date was declared a national day of celebration within Wales in the 18th century.

The Red Dragon is the heraldic symbol of Wales and is incorporated into the Welsh national flag. The red dragon reappeared as the royal badge for Wales in 1807 and from then on it was often seen in the regalia of Welsh patriotic societies. At the suggestion of the Gorsedd of the Bards, it was officially recognised by the Queen in 1959, and is now widely used as the national flag.

The leek and the daffodil are both emblems of Wales. They share the Welsh name Ceninenn. The leek is known to have been displayed as a Welsh emblem in 1536 although its association with Wales can in fact be traced back to the battle of Heathfield in 633 AD. The daffodil has no such claim to literary and historical distinction. It has only recently assumed a position of national importance when its status was elevated by the Welsh-born Prime Minister, David Lloyd George, who wore it on St David's Day and at important ceremonies such as the investiture of the Prince of Wales at Caernarfon in 1911.

The National Eisteddfod is the largest and oldest celebration of Welsh culture. It dates back to 1176. Eisteddfod literally means a sitting (eistedd = to sit), perhaps a reference to the hand-carved chair traditionally awarded to the best poet in the ceremony 'The Crowning of the Bard'.

The beautiful sound of the Welsh harp is heard on many occasions - weddings, funerals and concerts. Harps are very important to Wales. The harp's musical heritage is deeply and passionately entrenched in our culture, and the harp is undoubtedly our national instrument.

Traditionally, Wales is referred to as the Land of Song and we have to mention the Welsh Male Voice Choirs that originated in the late 19th century. During the late 1940's and early 50's many choirs gathered in the Welsh villages and the beautiful sound of the modern male voice choirs was born.
