Advanced Welsh Baccalaureate Diploma

Students leaving school or college with the Welsh Baccalaureate Diploma will have had a broader and richer experience. The value of the Welsh Baccalaureate is recognised by the 120 points allocated to this Diploma in the UCAS tariff - the equivalent to an A grade at GCE A level.

Requirements for the Advanced Diploma

To gain a Welsh Baccalaureate Advanced Diploma, students must achieve the Welsh Bac core and also pass the optional studies which must be equivalent to 108 credits or more. These include: 2 A Levels or a Level 3 Diploma or an Extended Diploma.

Welsh Baccalaureate Core at Level 3:

You must pass all 3 essential and key skills and all 3 wider key skills of which a minimum of three must be at Level 3 and three at Level 2. At least one main key skill or essential skill must be at Level 3. You will also need to complete a diary to evaluate your studies in the following mandatory core modules: Personal and Social Education, Wales, Europe and the World (including the language module) and Work Related Education; Enterprise and Community Work. You will also complete Individual Investigation coursework at Level 3.

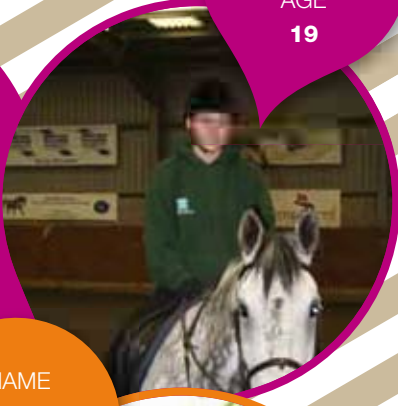
